The Royal Agricultural Society Foundation (RASf) was established in 2007 to help build strong, sustainable and resilient rural and regional communities in NSW.

Purpose of the RAS Foundation Rural Scholarship: To support students who are passionate and committed to forging careers that will contribute to the future success of rural and regional NSW including the ACT.

Value: Up to \$6,000 for full-time study or \$3,000 for part-time study.

Who can apply?

- Applicants of any age are eligible to apply.
- Applicants must be applying for, or holding admission to, a course with relevance to rural and regional NSW including the ACT.
- Applicants must be studying at a registered higher education provider. This can be a university, TAFE or college.
- Applicants must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident.

Selection priorities based on:

- Financial need.
- Desire to actively contribute in rural and regional NSW including the ACT.
- Demonstrated interest in rural issues and involvement in the local community.

Applications open: Friday 1 July 2022

Application close: Monday 5 September 2022

Scholarship Funds: Awarded in three instalments commencing in April 2023 for use in the 2023 academic year.

GUIDELINES FOR COMPLETING THE BUDGET SECTION

Course fees - only include course fees that you are unable/have opted not to pay for via a HELP-HECS loan or VET Student Loan.

Relocation fees - these are one-off costs that you may incur when relocating from home to campus. It may include transportation of your belongings to campus; purchase of furniture if moving into unfurnished accommodation and bond for rental accommodation for example. It does not include weekly rent in shared housing or campus accommodation even if you are required to pay these up-front. Costs associated with rent and accommodation should be included in your weekly expenses.

Practical placement costs - these are costs that you may incur if you are required to temporarily relocate to participate in practical placements for your course. These may include additional transportation costs and accommodation costs.

Employment income - average your income out on a weekly basis. For example, if you are only able to work during your holidays please total your expected income for the year based on this work schedule and average to get a weekly amount.

On-campus board and lodging - average any annual or term costs to a weekly basis.
